TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF LOS ANGELES DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND POWER—HANSEN AREA WATER RECYCLING PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION PROJECT, 11801 SHELDON STREET, SUN VALLEY, LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9014)

In our letter dated January 19, 2007, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your May 10, 2007, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that the above-referenced project has been completed and groundwater was not encountered at the subject project site.

On September 27, 2007, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

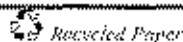
