**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ENVIRONMENTAL CHECKLIST AND ADOPTING A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION (RESOLUTION NO. R06-018) AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS (ORDER NO. Dear Ms. Glantz:

Pur letter dated July 5, 2006, transmitted the tentative Resolution and Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for the subject site.

Pursuant to Division 7 of the California Water Code, this Regional Board at a public hearing held on September 14, 2006, reviewed the tentative resolution and WDRs, considered all factors in the case, and adopted the Resolution No. R06-018 and Order No. R4-2006-0072 (copies attached) relative to this waste discharge. Section 13263 (e) of the California Water Code provides that all Requirements shall be reviewed periodically and, upon such review, may be revised by the Regional Board.

Please do not combine your discharge monitoring reports with other reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.
