
TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF MONROVIA, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, GROUNDWATER TREATMENT PLANT, 2655 S. MYRTLE AVENUE, MONROVIA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES CAG994005, CI—9101)

In our letter dated June 1, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On December 12, 2007, you informed the Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project was completed in November 2007. On April 4, 2008, our staff inspected the facility, and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water becomes necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters. 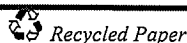
