TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CITY OF LYNWOOD, WELL NO. 19, 2600 INDUSTRY WAY, LYNWOOD, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994005, CI-9105)

In our letter dated June 2, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

In a letter dated June 13, 2007, you requested termination of the subject permit because you have ceased your discharge. On September 19, 2007, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to surface waters from the project.

Since there is no discharge from the site, coverage under Board Order R4-2002-0108 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
