Dear Ms. Goff,

On August 18, 2006, this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2005-0030 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated May 22, 2013, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased re-injection of treated groundwater at the subject site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Since G&M Oil Company, Inc. has no plan to re-inject treated groundwater in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2005-0030, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
