TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF SIGNAL HILL, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, WELL NO. 9, 2203 EAST 28TH STREET, SIGNAL HILL, CALIFORNIA (NPDES CAG994005, CI—9149)

In our letter dated August 11, 2006, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0108, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Potable Water Supply Wells to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On October 24, 2008, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project was completed on April 30, 2008. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, you requested termination of your coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit. On February 5, 2009, our staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge to the storm drain.

Since there is no discharge from the site to the storm drain, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0108 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water becomes necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any groundwater from the site to surface waters.
