TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—CITY OF VENTURA PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY, CORRUGATED METAL PIPE AND DRAINAGE INFRASTRUCTURE REPLACEMENT, HARBOR BLVD. & OLIVAS PARK DR., VENTURA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9284)

In our letter dated August 22, 2007, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your February 1, 2010, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have completed your construction project and ceased groundwater discharge.

On February 26, 2010, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface waters. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under the Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

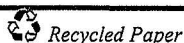

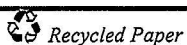
