TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—ANNENBERG COMMUNITY BEACH CLUB, SANTA MONICA STATE BEACH, 415 PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY, SANTA MONICA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9291)

In our letter dated July 18, 2007, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2003-0111, Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of *Discharges of Groundwater from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on August 7, 2003, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your November 11, 2008 letter, requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that you have obtained a permit from the City of Santa Monica to discharge groundwater from the construction project to their sewer system and no discharge has ever occurred from the project site to the storm drain.

On December 03, 2008, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of wastewater from the site to the Pacific Ocean. Since there is no discharge from the subject site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2003-0111, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject project is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface waters become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain waste discharge requirements.

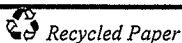

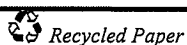
