09799)**


In our letter dated September 17, 2007, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0019, Series No. 029, which also serves as your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

By letter dated December 19, 2008, you notified the Regional Board that In-situ Chemical Oxidation for remediation of total petroleum hydrocarbons performed is not appropriate for the site due to the safety concerns and that you requested rescission of the WDR.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in the 2008 Second Quarterly Report. Since the In-situ Chemical Oxidation will not be implemented at the site, the WDR is no longer needed, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, Series No. 029 for the subject facility is hereby terminated.
