Dear Mr. Ortega:

In our letter dated November 27, 2007, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0019, (Series No. 040), which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated October 8, 2010, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased Fenton's Reagent injection for this site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Because the ongoing remediation does not plan to continue to inject Fenton's Reagent, you no longer need the WDR. The coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, (Series No. 040), for the subject facility is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
