**TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS – NIX AUTOMOTIVE, 20032 VENTURA BOULEVARD, WOODLAND HILLS, CALIFORNIA (ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 050, CI-9381)**

Dear Mr. and Ms. Nix:


In our letter dated February 25, 2008, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2007-0019, Series No. 050, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated June 25, 2009, you notified the Regional Board that ozone injection for groundwater cleanup of total petroleum hydrocarbons performed for the site will cease on July 1, 2009 and that you requested termination of the WDR.

The monitoring results were provided to the Regional Board in quarterly monitoring reports. We have reviewed the data and concur with your plan to terminate the WDR. Since you plan to cease the injection of ozone into groundwater and no longer need the WDR, the coverage under Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, Series No. 050 for the subject facility is hereby terminated effective on June 30, 2009.

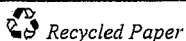
