TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—KINDER MORGAN ENERGY PARTNERS, LOS ANGELES HARBOR TERMINAL, 2200 JOHN S. GIBSON BOULEVARD, SAN PEDRO (CAG674001, CI—9395)


Dear Mr. Granado:

In our letter dated July 16, 2008, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2004-0109, *General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Low Threat Hydrostatic Test Water to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On August 10, 2009, you informed Regional Board staff that the above-referenced project was completed in July 2008. Therefore, the subject NPDES permit is no longer needed. On November 18, 2009, Regional Board staff inspected the facility and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater to the nearby channel.

Since there is no discharge from the site to the channel, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2004-0109 for the subject facility is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes. Please note that if future discharges of hydrostatic test water to surface water becomes necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this office and obtain Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) prior to discharging any hydrostatic test water from the site to surface waters.

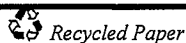
