COVERAGE UNDER STATEWIDE GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES FROM UTILITY VAULTS AND UNDERGROUND STRUCTURES TO SURFACE WATERS—GLENDALE WATER & POWER DEPARTMENT, GLENDALE, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG990002, WDID #4000U000099, CI-9503)

Your agency submitted an application to obtain coverage under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit for Discharges from Utility Vaults and Underground Structures to Surface Waters, Order No. 2006-0008-DWQ (Permit). The application consisted of a Notice of Intent to comply with the terms of the Permit and a Pollution Prevention Plan (PLAN).

The PLAN was reviewed and appears to comply with the intent and requirements of the permit. The PLAN was also made available to the public for review and comment and the public had the opportunity to request a public hearing. No comments were received and no public hearing was requested.

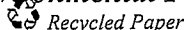

Therefore, your application is hereby approved and discharge from your utility vaults and underground structures is authorized pursuant to the Permit, which requires that you implement the PLAN and comply with all of its other conditions.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, which also serves as your NPDES permit, consisting of Water Quality Order No. 2006-0008-DWQ and Monitoring and Reporting Program. The Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit. All monitoring reports should be sent to the Regional Board, ATTN: Information technology Unit.
