TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SPECIFIED DISCHARGES TO GROUNDWATER IN SANTA CLARA RIVER AND LOS ANGELES RIVER BASINS – CITY OF CAMARILLO – SPRINGVILLE DRIVE OVERPASS-DEWATERING FOR SEWER EXTENSION INSTALLATION PROJECT, CAMARILLO, CALIFORNIA (FILE NO. 09-067, CI NO. 9514, GLOBAL ID WDR100000185)

Dear Mr. Foxx:

In our letter dated July 29, 2011, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. 93-010, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated December 18, 2012, Mr. Tom Charon, your representative, notified the Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) that discharges of groundwater for the project involving the the installation of 600 feet of 12-inch sewer line is complete and that you request termination of the WDR.

Since the discharge of groundwater has been ceased, and the WDR is no longer needed, the coverage under Regional Board Order No. 93-010, Series No. 040 for the subject facility is hereby terminated.
