**TERMINATION OF GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR VENTURA COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT – CAMARILLO CAMPUS, NORTHWEST CORNER OF LOS POSAS ROAD AND PLEASANT VALLEY ROAD, CAMARILLO, CALIFORNIA 93010 (FILE NO. 09-112, ORDER NO. R4-2007-0019, SERIES NO. 099, CI-9528, GLOBAL ID WDR100000662)**


Dear Mr. Evans:

On September 9, 2009, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the injection of 88,850 gallons of 3% potassium permanganate solution for the treatment of groundwater at the Ventura County Community College District – Camarillo Campus is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In a letter dated February 18, 2014, you requested the termination of the WDR coverage under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 because the injection of chemicals for the treatment of groundwater has completed. The last injection was performed in April 19, 2010. Therefore, the WDR is no longer needed. The coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the term of the permit.
