TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT—CITY OF PORT HUENEME—J PUMP STATION ELIMINATION PROJECT, VENTURA COUNTY RAILROAD TRACKS BETWEEN J STREET AND PERKINS ROAD, PORT HUENEME, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9532)

In our letter dated August 19, 2009, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Groundwater From Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, adopted by this Board on June 5, 2008, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have received and reviewed your March 8, 2010, letter requesting termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that all groundwater collected from the aforementioned construction project was discharged to the city's sanitary sewer system. Therefore, the subject general permit is no longer needed.

On March 24, 2010, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the subject project site to the storm drain. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject project is hereby terminated except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharge of any groundwater to surface water becomes necessary at the project site, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate waste discharge requirements.
