TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS—SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON, SILVER STRAND BEACH CONSTRUCTION, VARIOUS STREETS ADJACENT TO SILVER STRAND BEACH, UNINCORPORATED AREA OF VENTURA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. 
In our letter dated September 10, 2010, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, *General National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties*, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

We have reviewed your July 19, 2010, letter which requested termination of your coverage under the General Permit. The letter indicated that the above-referenced project has been completed.

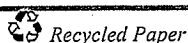
On November 19, 2010, Board staff inspected the project site and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface waters. Since there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface waters, coverage under the Board Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES Permit No. CAG994004, for the subject site is hereby terminated.

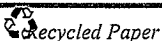
