Dear Mr. Puig:


On November 16, 2009 this Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019 which specifies your Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR).

In the letter dated October 9, 2012, you notified the Regional Board that you ceased injection of Fenton's reagent at the subject site and that you requested termination of the WDR.

Since ExxonMobil Environmental Services has no plan to inject Fenton's reagent in the future, the coverage for the subject facility, under Regional Board Order No. R4-2007-0019, is hereby terminated with the exception of enforcement under the terms of the permit.
