TERMINATION OF COVERAGE UNDER GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS— CITY OF ARCADIA, HUGO REID WELL AND ORANGE GROVE WELLS 1A AND 2A, 1128 DE ANZA PLACE AND 67 WEST ORANGE GROVE AVENUE, ARCADIA, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG994004, CI-9805)

Dear Mr. Herman:

In our letter dated March 4. 2013, we informed you that the subject discharge is regulated under Order No. R4-2008-0032, General NPDES and Waste Discharge Requirements for Groundwater Discharges from Construction and Project Dewatering to Surface Waters in Coastal Watersheds of Los Angeles and Ventura Counties, which also serves as your NPDES permit.

On November 19, 2013, City of Arcadia (City) informed the Regional Board that the City has concluded all discharges related to the subject project. Since the NPDES permit is no longer necessary, the City requested termination of coverage under the above-referenced General NPDES permit.

On December 20, 2013, Regional Board staff inspected the subject project and verified that there is no discharge of groundwater from the site to surface water. Therefore, coverage under Board Order No. R4-2008-0032 for the subject project is hereby terminated, except for enforcement purposes.

Please note that if future discharges of groundwater to surface water or land become necessary, you must file a Report of Waste Discharge with this Board and obtain appropriate Waste Discharge Requirements.
