**COVERAGE UNDER STATEWIDE GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT AND WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES FROM UTILITY VAULTS AND UNDERGROUND STRUCTURES TO SURFACE WATERS—VEOLIA ENERGY LOS ANGELES INC., CULVER CITY FACILITY, CALIFORNIA (NPDES NO. CAG990002, ORDER NO. 2006-0008-DWQ, CI-9920)**

Veolia Energy Los Angeles, Inc. submitted an application to obtain coverage under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit for Discharges from Utility Vaults and Underground Structures to Surface Waters, Order No. 2006-0008-DWQ (Permit). The application, consisted of a Notice of Intent (NOI) to comply with the terms of the Permit and a Pollution Prevention Plan (PLAN).

We have reviewed the PLAN and it complies with the intent and requirements of the permit. The PLAN was also made available to the public for review and comment and the public had the opportunity to request a public hearing. No comments were received and no public hearing was requested.

You have fulfilled the requirements for obtaining coverage under the Permit. Therefore, your application is hereby approved and discharge from your utility vaults and underground structures is authorized pursuant to the Permit, which requires that you implement the PLAN and comply with all of its other conditions.

Enclosed are your Waste Discharge Requirements, which also serves as your NPDES permit, consisting of Water Quality Order No. 2006-0008-DWQ and Monitoring and Reporting Program. The Monitoring and Reporting Program requires you to implement the monitoring program on the effective date of coverage under this permit. When submitting monitoring or technical reports to the Regional Board per these requirements, please include a reference to "Compliance File No. CI-9920 and NPDES No. CAG990002", which will assure that the reports are directed to the appropriate file and staff. Also, please do not combine other reports with your monitoring reports. Submit each type of report as a separate document.
