NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY; GENERAL SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION ORDER REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ST. SUPERY ESTATE VINEYARDS & WINERY, DOLLARHIDE RD. MAXWELL CREEK PARCEL 1 EROSION PROJECT (WDID#5A28CR00050), NAPA COUNTY

On 3 January 2025, St. Supery Estate Vineyards & Winery (Applicant) filed a notification requesting coverage under the 20 September 2024 State Water Resources Control Board Clean Water Act Section 401 General Water Quality Certification of the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Regional General Permit 5 (WQ 2024-0085-DWQ) (General Certification Order) for the Dollarhide Rd. Maxwell Creek Parcel 1 Erosion Project (Project). After review of the notification and the supplemental material submitted by the Applicant, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has determined that the Project qualifies for enrollment under this General Certification Order. The proposed activity is taking place within approximately 20 cubic yards of waters of the United States.

The Central Valley Water Board is certifying this Project under United States Army Corps of Engineers Regional General Permit 5, Emergency Repair and Protection Activities, subject to the conditions and the notification requirements described in the Nationwide Permit ("Special Conditions"). This Notice of Applicability is being issued under the General Certification Order pursuant to Section 3838 of the California Code of Regulations.

The Project is being conducted in accordance with the requirements contained in this Notice of Applicability and General Certification Order. The Project is described in the notification form requesting coverage under the General Certification Order, dated 3 January 2025, and supplementary information (Application Package). Coverage under

the General Certification Order is no longer valid if the Project (as described) is modified.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The 20 cubic yard Dollarhide Rd. Maxwell Creek Parcel 1 Erosion Project (Project) consists of the placement of 20 cubic yards of rip rap to an impacted area along the bank measuring approximately 10 feet by 20 feet. The rip rap will be placed by hand or by excavator from the top of the bank and secured with landscape fabric staples.

The Project will permanently impact 20 cubic yards of waters of the United States.

PROJECT LOCATION:

The Project is located at 2326 Dollarhide Rd. in Saint Helena.

PROJECT SCHEDULE:

The Project started construction on 13 December 2024 and notification will be provided when the Project is complete.

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

An application fee of \$4,212.00 was received on 9 January 2025.

The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3833(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3), and was calculated as category F- Emergency Projects authorized by a Water Board General Order (fee code 85) with the dredge and fill fee calculator.
