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**ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY
CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; CITY OF SACRAMENTO,
GARCIA BEND BOAT RAMP SILT REMOVAL PROJECT (WDID#5A34CR00591A2),
SACRAMENTO COUNTY**

This Order responds to the 2 June 2025 request for an amendment of the Garcia Bend Boat Ramp Silt Removal Project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5A34CR00591). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 6 June 2014 and amended on 23 May 2024. The requested amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

The City of Sacramento is requesting a time extension through 26 September 2035. A time extension was authorized by the United States Army Corps of Engineers on 26 September 2025. The City of Sacramento has provided documentation from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (SPK-2006-00136) authorizing in-water construction activities to continue until 26 September 2035.

The Certification is amended to expire on 26 September 2035.

No fee was required for this amendment. Total fees of \$944.00 and \$619.00 for the original Certification were received on 18 October 2013 and 2 June 2014, respectively.
