ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 TECHNICALLY CONDITIONED WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION; K. HOVANIAN HOMES, THE RANCH PROJECT (WDID#5A34CR00797A3), SACRAMENTO COUNTY

This Order responds to the 18 February 2025 request for an amendment of the Ranch project (Project) Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID#5A34CR00797). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 22 July 2020. The Certification was amended on 6 August 2020 (WDID#5A34CR00797A1) and 9 November 2022 (WDID#5A34CR00797A2). The requested third amendment is hereby approved. The original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

K. Hovanian Homes is requesting a time extension through 28 September 2030. A time extension was authorized by the United States Army Corps of Engineers on 29 September 2020. K. Hovanian Homes has provided documentation from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (SPK-2004-00707) authorizing in-water construction activities to continue until 28 September 2030.

K. Hovanian Homes is also requesting a change in area of impacts. The total area of impact to waters of the state cited in the original Water Quality Certification is 7.07 acres, and the revised total area of impact is 8.33 acres, an increase of 1.26 acres.

The Certification is amended to reflect the updated expiration date of 28 September 2030. Additionally, the following tables are updated as shown below:




Figure 2 – Site Map
