NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY FOR COVERAGE UNDER ORDER SB12006GN, AMENDED ORDER FOR CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 GENERAL WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION FOR SMALL HABITAT RESTORATION PROJECTS, BLACK DIAMOND MINES POND 20 DESEDIMENTATION AND RESTORATION PROJECT (WDID#5B07CR00259), CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

On 29 May 2024, the East Bay Regional Park District submitted a Notice of Intent (NOI) to enroll under and comply with State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) Order No. SB12006GN, Amended Order for Clean Water Act Section 401 General Water Quality Certification for Small Habitat Restoration Projects.

The Central Valley Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) has reviewed your enrollment materials and finds the Black Diamond Mines Pond 20 Desedimentation and Restoration Project (Project) meets the requirements of, and is hereby enrolled under, Order No. SB12006GN. You may proceed with your Project in accordance with the Order.

Please familiarize yourself with the requirements of Order No. SB12006GN. You are responsible for complying with all applicable Order requirements. Failure to comply with Order No. SB12006GN constitutes a violation of the California Water Code and may result in enforcement action or termination of enrollment under the Order.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The 0.54-acre Project consists of the desiltation of three livestock ponds (Pond 20, Pond 5, and Pond 23), repair of spillways on one pond, improvement of a stretch of access road that is eroding into the ponds, and the installation of a new livestock water installation to allow for rotational grazing.

Project elements for Pond 20 that affect aquatic resources include sediment removal, spoils placement, and vehicle and equipment access. The Project will temporarily impact 0.12 acres/150 linear feet. Temporarily impacted areas will be restored to pre-Project condition.

PROJECT LOCATION:

The Project is located within an unnamed waterbody within the Black Diamond Mines Regional Preserve, an East Bay Regional Park District property located in Antioch (Parcel 075-103-001). The approximate center of the Project area is located at latitude 37.957755° and longitude -121.860576°.

PROJECT SCHEDULE:

The project is projected to begin September 2024 and end November 2024. The work will be conducted during the allowable CDFW/USFWS seasonal work period. The project is estimated to take approximately 15 workdays.

APPLICATION FEE RECEIVED:

\$796.00 was received on 3 June 2024. The fee amount was determined as required by California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 3833(b)(3) and 2200(a)(3) and was calculated as category D - Ecological Restoration and Enhancement Projects (fee code 85).

NOTICE OF COMPLETION:

Upon completion of the Project, you shall submit a Notice of Completion (NOC) no later than 30 days after Project completion. The NOC shall demonstrate the Project was carried out in accordance with the Project description, include a map of the Project location with final boundaries of the restoration area, and include post-project photographs. More information on the NOC is listed in section B.6 of the Order.
