TENTATIVE RESCISSION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS ORDER 5-00-148, GENE FENN, FENN HUNTING CLUB WASTEWATER TREATMENT POND, BUTTE COUNTY

TO ALL CONCERNED PERSONS AND AGENCIES:

Enclosed is a tentative Order for Rescission of Waste Discharge Requirements for the discharge of wastewater to an evaporation/percolation pond at Fenn Hunting Club (Facility). To be given full consideration, any comments or recommendations you have concerning the tentative Order must be submitted in writing to the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) office by **5:00 pm on 14 April 2025**. Written materials submitted after this date and time will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party. Please note that the tentative documents will receive internal legal and management review during the public comment period.

A Public Hearing has been scheduled for the Central Valley Water Board to consider adoption of the tentative Order at its **19/20 June 2025** Board Meeting. The Notice of Public Hearing (4 copies) and a copy of a Proof of Posting form are also enclosed. **By 21 March 2025** post one (1) copy of the Notice of Public Hearing at:

- The entrance to the Facility;
- The nearest city hall or county courthouse; and
- The post office nearest to the Facility (if allowed).

Proof of posting, using the enclosed form, shall be filed with this office by **28 March 2025**.

To conserve resources, this letter transmits a paper copy of the tentative documents to the Discharger only. Interested persons are advised that the full text of the tentative
