PUBLIC NOTICE: PROPOSED PETROLEUM UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK CASE CLOSURE

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: 1st June to 30th July 2026

The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) is asking for public comments. We plan to close the leaking tank case, known as George Jandera. The property is located at 160 8th Street East in Davis, California.

The property was developed in 1958 as a fuel service station and was in use from 1961 to 1991. In July 1991, evidence of a leak was discovered on the property during the removal of four underground storage tanks previously used to store gasoline and waste oil. Further sampling and monitoring indicated that the leak had caused both groundwater and soil contamination.

In 2001, planning was started to determine how to address impacts. From 2004 to 2007, multiple methods were tested to determine the most effective way to remove the contaminants from the property.

In 2011, the owner installed an extraction system at the property to remove contaminated groundwater and petroleum vapor. The owner operated the system periodically between July 2011 and October 2016, removing approximately 2.8 million gallons of contaminated groundwater and 68,676 pounds of petroleum vapor.

In March 2026, the contractor hired by the property owner determined that the case was ready to be closed.
