**UPDATED NOTICE of PUBLIC HEARING  
for**

**Tentative Time Schedule Order No. R9-2023-0006  
An Order Requiring Designated Responsible Permittees  
to Comply with Bacteria, Project I-Twenty Beaches and Creeks Total Maximum  
Daily Load Requirements Prescribed in the Regional Municipal Separate Storm  
Sewer Systems Permit for the San Diego Region**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is releasing, for public review and comment, Tentative Time Schedule Order (TSO) No. R9-2023-0006, *An Order Requiring Designated Responsible Permittees to Comply With Bacteria, Project I-Twenty Beaches and Creeks Total Maximum Daily Load Requirements Prescribed in the Regional Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems Permit for the San Diego Region (Regional MS4 Permit)*. The Tentative TSO provides additional time to comply with the requirements of the Bacteria, Project I-Twenty Beaches and Creeks Total Maximum Daily Loads (Bacteria TMDLs) described in Specific Provision 6, Attachment E of the Regional MS4 Permit with respect to final dry weather water quality based effluent limitations for fecal indicator bacteria (FIB). The Tentative TSO includes interim milestones to protect public health and attain compliance with the final dry weather requirements. The San Diego Water Board held a public workshop on the Tentative TSO at its regularly scheduled meeting on February 8, 2023. The San Diego Water Board received information and discussed the proposed requirements in the Tentative TSO. The Board took no action. The San Diego Water Board is currently reviewing comments received by the deadline of February 17, 2023.
