The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is considering the adoption of tentative Order No. R9-2023-0132 (Tentative Order), Cleanup and Abatement and Water Code section 13267 Investigative Order to Temecula Creek Ranch, LLC (TCR); the Edward and Jean Ward Trust (Trust); Jacqueline M. Fletcher; and Jose Antonio Jimenez (Responsible Parties). The Tentative Order requires the cleanup and abatement of wastes pursuant to Water Code section 13304, and the preparation and submittal of technical and monitoring reports to the San Diego Water Board pursuant to Water Code section 13267 by the Responsible Parties. The Tentative Order is in response to the unauthorized discharge of waste into and around Temecula Creek, a “waters of the United States” and “waters of the State” in Assessor Parcel Numbers (APNs) 583-120-003, 583-120-004 and 583-120-086 (Site), Aguanga, County of Riverside during construction activity on or about August 2021.
