Proposed Settlement of Potential Civil Liability for
Alleged Violation of Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R9-2005-0259

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board) will consider a settlement offer from Glenwood Development Co. for an alleged violation at the Palmilla Construction Site (Northwest corner of Jackson Avenue and Nutmeg Street, Murrieta, California). Glenwood allegedly violated Cleanup and Abatement Order No. R9-2005-0259 Directive No. 3 by failing to provide on-site restoration by January 31, 2006, and has offered to pay \$15,000 to settle any potential civil liability for the alleged violations without admitting the alleged violation or waiving its right to a hearing on the alleged violation.

Written public comments regarding the settlement offer will be accepted through November 6, 2006. The settlement offer will be considered by the Regional Board at its November 8, 2006 meeting at the Regional Board office located at 9174 Sky Park Court, San Diego, California. Oral comments will be accepted at the meeting that will begin at 9 a.m.
