




As per your request on February 27, 2007 the temporary dams have been removed from the Long Valley Channel. Please see the photos below which reflect the current condition where the temporary dams were located:

Long Valley Channel at Loop Road






Long Valley and Butterfield Stage Road

I want to clarify that the primary purpose of these temporary dams was to protect the bridge structures during the construction of the bridges and that they were installed within the authorization provided by the Streambed Alteration Agreement issued by the California Department of Fish and Game (Notification No. 6-2001-205). In the Operator Notification the agreement states that we ... "intend to divert or obstruct the natural flow of....the Santa Gertrudis Creek and Long Valley Wash..." A copy of the Streambed Alteration Agreement has been attached for your convenience. The fact that the temporary dams serve as a BMP is an incidental consequence of the temporary dams. There was no intention of using the channel as a BMP with the exception of what is required by the Streambed Alteration Agreement.
