COMPLAINT NO. R9-2007-0096 FOR ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY AGAINST EASTERN MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT FOR SANITARY SEWER DISCHARGE AT DIAZ ROAD LIFT STATION, TEMECULA, RIVERSIDE COUNTY

Enclosed please find Administrative Civil Liability Complaint No. R9-2007-0096 against the Eastern Municipal Water District (District) for a discharge of raw sewage at Diaz Road Lift Station (WDID No. 9 000000763) located in the City of Temecula in Riverside County. The Complaint includes a civil liability in the amount of \$53,500 for violations of California State Water Resources Control Board No. 2006-0003-DWQ, Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems and California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board) Order No. 96-04, General Waste Discharge Requirements Prohibiting Sanitary Sewer Overflows by Sewage Collection Agencies. Attached to this letter is the Technical Report that documents the basis for Complaint No. R9-2007-0096.

Waiver of Hearing

The District may elect to waive its right to a hearing before the Regional Board. Waiver of the hearing constitutes admission of the validity of the allegation of violation in the Complaint and acceptance of the assessment of civil liability in the amount of \$53,500 as set forth in the Complaint. For the Regional Board to accept the waiver of the District's right to a public hearing, the District must submit the following by 5 P.M., November 16, 2007:

- 1. The enclosed waiver form signed by an authorized agent of the District;
- 2. A check for the full amount of civil liability of \$53,500 made out to the California State Water Resources Control Board; and

3. Verification that the enclosed public notice has been published in a newspaper circulated in the District's area.

Public Hearing

If the District does not elect to waive their right to a public hearing, a hearing is tentatively scheduled to be held at the Regional Board meeting on <u>December 12, 2007</u>. The meeting is scheduled to begin at 9 A.M. If the District intends to present any written exculpatory evidence, or written evidence at the hearing in response to Complaint No. R9-2007-0096, such evidence must be received by 5 P.M. on November 26, 2007, in order to be considered by the Regional Board at the public hearing.

The Submittal of Written Information Procedures further describing the written materials and prescribed submittal dates required by the Regional Board and Hearing Procedures for the public hearing will be mailed to you at a later date prior to the hearing date. An agenda for the hearing will also be mailed to you approximately 10 days before the hearing date.

VIOLATIONS OF

STATE WATER BOARD ORDER No. 2006-0003-DWQ AND REGIONAL BOARD ORDER 96-04

EASTERN MUNICIPAL WATER DISTRICT IS HEREBY GIVEN NOTICE THAT:

- 1. The Eastern Municipal Water District (District) is alleged to have violated provisions of law for which the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (Regional Board) may impose civil liability pursuant to the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act, §13350 of the California Water Code (CWC). The violation, alleged herein, includes violation of a prohibition in waste discharge requirements for the discharges of untreated sewage at any point upstream of a sewage treatment plant.
- 2. The District's sewage conveyance system is regulated by:
 - a. State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Order No. 2006-0003-DWQ, Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Sanitary Sewer Systems.
 - b. Order No. 96-04, General Waste Discharge Requirements Prohibiting Sanitary Sewer Overflows by Sewage Collection Agencies.

These Orders establish minimum requirements to prevent sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) from publicly owned/operated sanitary sewer system.

3. This Administrative Civil Liability Complaint is issued under authority of Water Code Section 13323.

4. The discharge of 1.07 million gallons of untreated sewage from a ruptured a 10-inch force main resulted in the District violating the following requirements:

Prohibitions C.1 and C.2 of Order No. 2006-003-DWQ state the following:

- C.1. Any SSO that results in a discharge of untreated or partially treated wastewater to waters of the United States is prohibited.
- C.2. Any SSO that results in a discharge of untreated or partially treated wastewater that creates a nuisance as defined in California Water Code Section 13050(m) is prohibited.

Prohibition A.1 of Order 96-04 states:

A.1 The discharge of sewage from a sanitary sewer system at any point upstream of a sewage treatment plan is prohibited.

ALLEGATIONS

5. On November 14, 2006, the District violated Prohibitions C.1 and C.2 of State Board Order No. 2006-003-DWQ, and Prohibition A.1 of Regional Board Order No. 96-04, by discharging a total of 1.07 million gallons of sewage from its 10-inch diameter force sewer main at the Diaz Road Lift Station, into Murrieta Creek, and a tributary to the Santa Margarita River, waters of the United States.

PROPOSED CIVIL LIABILITY

6. Persons or entities that discharge waste in violation of Waste Discharge Requirements are subject to civil liability pursuant to California Water Code Sections 13350, either on a daily basis, not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for each day the violation occurs, or on a per gallon basis, not to exceed ten dollars (\$10) for each gallon of waste discharged, but not both. The statutory maximum ACL amount for the November 14, 2006 sewage discharge therefore is \$10,700,000. Based upon consideration of the factors discussed in the Staff Report, however, a reduction of the ACL amount from the statutory limit is warranted.

7. Pursuant to sections 13350(e) of the CWC, the Regional Board impose a civil liability of fifty three thousand, five hundred dollars (\$53,500) on the Eastern Municipal Water District alleged violation in Finding 5.
