SUBJECT: TENTATIVE ORDER NO. R9-2009-0094; NPDES PERMIT NO.

CAG679001; GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES OF HYDROSTATIC TEST WATER AND POTABLE WATER TO SURFACE WATERS AND STORM DRAINS OR OTHER CONVEYANCE SYSTEMS WITHIN THE SAN DIEGO REGION

Enclosed is a copy of Tentative Order No. R9-2009-0094, NPDES Permit No. CAG679001, including a monitoring and reporting program and fact sheet which Regional Board staff intends to present to the Regional Board for adoption at their regularly scheduled meeting on August 12, 2009.

If adopted, tentative Order No. R9-2009-0094, NPDES Permit No. CAG679001, would update waste discharge requirements for the discharge of waste associated with hydrostatic test water and potable water to surface waters within the San Diego Region. If adopted, Order No. R9-2008-0082 would supersede Order No. R9-2002-0020, except for enforcement purposes.

The August 12, 2009 meeting will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and will be held at the following location:

Please review and comment on the tentative order at your earliest convenience. It is recommended that written comments be submitted as soon as possible to enable staff to amend the tentative order, if necessary, and allow changes to the tentative order to be fully reviewed by the Regional Board and interested persons.

The public comment period will remain open until the Regional Board takes action on August 12, 2009. However, to ensure that the Regional Board has the opportunity to
