Table 1. Discharger Information

Dischargers	Water distributors (also called purveyors), water districts, municipalities, private entities, and other persons, that have been issued a water supply permit by the California Department of Public Health, <u>or federal military installations</u> , that discharge hydrostatic test water and/or potable water to surface waters within the San Diego Region and storm drains or other conveyance system tributary thereto (pursuant to Section 402 of the Clean Water Act) that do not cause, have a reasonable potential to cause, or contribute to instream excursion above any applicable State or Federal water quality objectives criteria or cause acute or chronic toxicity in the receiving water.

2. Section II. B of the Permit (page 6) is revised as follows:

B. Enrollment

Each of the persons listed below have been issued a water supply permit by the California Department of Public Health, or is a federal military installation, and owns or operates potable water distribution facilities and have a potential to discharge hydrostatic test water and/or potable water to waters of the United States within the San Diego Region and thus require enrollment under this Order:
