**Display Of Fireworks** 

Enclosed is a copy of Tentative Order No. R9-2011-0022, NPDES Permit No. CAG999002 (Tentative Order), including a monitoring and reporting program and fact sheet. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) intends to consider adoption of the enclosed subject Tentative Order at a San Diego Water Board meeting on May 11, 2011.

If adopted, the Tentative Order would establish waste discharge requirements for residual fireworks pollutant waste discharges to waters of the U.S. in the San Diego Region from the public display of fireworks. In the Tentative Order the public display of fireworks refers to an entertainment feature where the public or a private group is admitted to or permitted to view the display or discharge of fireworks.


The Tentative Order is a revised draft and incorporates comments received during the March 11, 2011 Public Workshop.

The final deadline for submittal of written comments, however, is Wednesday April 20, 2011. Per San Diego Water Board direction, written material submitted to the San Diego Water Board office after the final submittal deadline date of April 20, 2011 will not be provided to the San Diego Water Board members. Also, it is not likely that written material will be accepted by the San Diego Water Board on the day of the meeting.
