Item 8 – San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS)

- 4. Several Board Members had questions that were not answered at the Board Meeting. Southern California Edison will be invited back for another meeting in the next 3-12 months to address the following questions:
 - a. Update on the decommissioning process, including status of the spent nuclear fuel.
 - b. Explanation on calculation of shut down costs. Particularly, did estimates include inflation?
 - c. How many curies are stored on site relative to the amount at Chernobyl and Fukushima? How much was released from those two sites? What is the status of the area around those accidents out to 20 kilometers?

Board Member Abarbanel wants to meet with Southern California Edison to discuss development of a new strategy to compel a federal solution to the storage of spent nuclear fuel.

Course of Action: <u>David Barker</u> will work to schedule another update on the SONGS. <u>Dave Gibson</u> will discuss with the Board Chair how to approach development of a new strategy.
