Dr. Olson stated that the Arundo removal in the San Juan basin has been completed.

At Dr. Abarbanel's request, Sarah Mearon provided an update on the use of modern technology monitoring tools (Presentation).

Dr. Abarbanel indicated that he had asked Assembly Member Todd Gloria to assist in communicating environmental justice issues in Region 9 to the Attorney General's Bureau of Environmental Justice and obtaining their help in initiating action before there is a violation of environmental justice standards. Dr. Abarbanel emphasized that he is not asking Mr. Gloria to do anything but be a liaison between the Board and the Attorney General's office.

Mr. Smith welcomed Jill Harris as a Senior Environmental Scientist Specialist to the Wetland and Riparian Protection Unit. He also provided background information on the San Diego River Watershed Consortium reported in Item A2 of the Executive Officer's Report, and asked Board Members interested in participating to contact either Mr. Smith or Mr. Gibson.

In addition, Mr. Smith indicated that Item B3 of the Report was in response to issues raised during the Public Forum at the December Board Meeting.
