- 2. Chairman's, Board Members', State Water Board Liaison's, and Executive Officer's Reports. *These items were for Board discussion only. Public testimony was not allowed, and the Board took no formal action.*

Laurel Firestone provided an update on the Governor's Drought Emergency Proclamation, recent actions taken by the State Board, and upcoming actions to be taken. Laurel also responded to Board Member questions and comments.

Dr. Olson stated that the San Juan Basin Watershed has been undertaking a number of ground water studies to determine how much water can be maintained in the basin. Dr. Olson expressed interest that every new study has indicated that more study is necessary, but progress is being made. Dr. Olson indicated that two water districts have installed desalters.

Gary Strawn stated that he represents the Board on the San Diego River Conservancy Board, which has grown to include the Sweetwater, Otay, and Tijuana River Watersheds. Gary indicated that the Conservancy Board has allocated approximately \$12 million for fire prevention, primarily clearing out brush. Gary stated that the Conservancy Board had given approximately one million dollars to the City of Santee for their park restoration project and environmental improvement projects, including what is likely the country's largest trash collector and separator, which does not allow any of the trash collected to flow into the river.

Chair Cantú announced that there will be a Board Chairs' meeting on May 21<sup>st</sup>, during which the Board Chairs will meet with State Board staff to discuss upcoming actions and priorities.

David Gibson stated that staff is planning to bring a San Diego River Conservancy Board informational item to the Board later in the year, perhaps August or September. He also stated the USEPA, in response to a letter expressing community concerns, is granting \$100,000 to the Air Pollution Control District in San Diego to evaluate the potential health risks associated with aerosols from sewage flows and sewage-contaminated dust. He indicated that he will be meeting with both the Air Pollution Control District and CalEPA later in the month to see if there is a way to amplify that funding with State money. Mr. Gibson responded to Board Member questions and comments regarding the written Executive Officer's Report.

# Chair Cantú called a brief recess at 10:12 a.m. and reconvened the meeting at 10:18 a.m.
