The changes below are proposed to the specified sections of Revised Tentative Order No. R9-2023-0004 (Revised Tentative Order) (Supporting Document No. 6, Item 8 on the San Diego Water Board March 8, Board Meeting Agenda) to ensure the University of California San Diego (Discharger) has sufficient time to obtain regulatory approvals that may be needed to post signs at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography (Facility) outfalls. Added text is shown in <u>blue-underline</u> format and deleted text shown in <u>red</u> strikeout format:

Section 6.3.3.3 of the Revised Tentative Order is Modified as Shown:

6.3.3.3. Notification Signs Plan for Posting Signs

<u>The Discharger shall post at least one new permanent sign at each of the</u> <u>Facility outfalls (Outfalls 001, 002, 003, 004a, and 004b) within 180 days of the</u> <u>effective date of the Order. The sign(s) posted at each outfall shall be of a size</u> <u>that is easily readable by the public and must include wording that describes</u> <u>the discharge from the outfall in text that is easily visible and legible. Signs</u> <u>may also include a quick response (QR) code that members of the public may</u> <u>scan to obtain more information on discharges from the Facility outfalls.</u>

Within 180 days of the effective date of the Order, the Discharger shall submit a plan for posting at least one new sign at each of the Facility outfalls (Outfalls 001, 002, 003, 004a, and 004b). The plan must include the following information:

- Locations of the proposed signs in relation to the outfalls;
- Wording to be included on the proposed signs; and
- Estimated timeframe for installing the signs.

The plan may also include a picture of the proposed signs. Proposed signs must be of a size that is easily readable by the public and must include wording that describes the discharge from the outfall in text that is easily understandable. Proposed signs may also include a quick response (QR) code that members of the public may scan to obtain more information on discharges from the Facility outfalls.

Section 6.2.2.3 of Attachment F (Fact Sheet) of the Revised Tentative Order is Modified as Shown:

6.2.2.3. Notification Signs Plan for Posting Signs

<u>The Discharger is required to post at least one new notification sign at each of the Facility outfalls within 180 days of the effective date of the Order. The notification signs are to inform beach users of the presence of the discharges.</u>

The Discharger shall submit a plan for posting at least one new notification sign at each of the Facility outfalls (Outfalls 001, 002, 003, 004a, and 004b) within 180 days of the effective date of the Order. The proposed signs are to inform beach users of the presence of the discharges from the Facility outfalls.
