NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board), is releasing the revised *Tentative Nutrient Management Plan (NMP)* for Shady Maples Farm located at 28411 San Juan Creek Road, San Juan Capistrano for public review and written comment. This site-specific NMP will be implemented supplemental to the statewide Industrial General Permit (IGP, Order No. 2014-0057-DWQ, as amended) and serves as the combined measure to regulate the confined animal feeding operation at Shady Maples Farm. This NMP includes best management practices that are specific to this operation to control discharges of nutrients to surface waters, that when implemented, help to protect water quality. The San Diego Water Board is making available the NMP for a 30-day public comment period.
