NOTICE OF WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD FOR TENTATIVE AMENDMENT 2 TO NOTICE OF APPLICABILITY, GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR RESIDUAL FIREWORK POLLUTANT DISCHARGES TO WATERS OF THE UNITED STATES IN THE SAN DIEGO REGION FROM THE PUBLIC DISPLAY OF FIREWORKS, ORDER NO. R9-2022-0002, NPDES PERMIT NO. CAG999002 (GENERAL ORDER)

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is releasing for 30-day public review and comment tentative Amendment 2 of Big Bay Boom's Notice of Applicability (NOA) under the General Order. Tentative Amendment 2, if adopted, will modify Big Bay Boom's NOA to name the Port of San Diego the Discharger.
