The San Diego Water Board intends to issue a no further action letter for cleanup of an unauthorized release of petroleum fuel wastes from a leaking underground storage tank system at **2712 Washington Street, 2126 Main Street, 2103 Main Street, and 1913 Main Street, Julian, San Diego County** (Site). This public notice fulfills the Board's obligation to inform the public of completed corrective action as required by California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Division 3, chapter 16, Article 11, section 2728.

The 60-day public notification period starts on January 27, 2026, and ends on March 27, 2026. Any comments provided during the public notification period regarding this Site will be considered by the San Diego Water Board. The case files are available for public review by submitting a file review request to the Board office, or accessing them online from the GeoTracker database ([Chevron Facility](#), [Norms Service Station](#), [Roberta H. Green](#), and [Julian Cider Mill](#)). A [fact sheet](#) summarizing the technical details of the unauthorized release, corrective action, and the proposed closure, is also available on GeoTracker for public review. Provided no significant issues arise during the public notification period, the San Diego Water Board will issue a no further action letter after the completion of Site monitoring well destruction and waste removal from the Site by the responsible party, Chevron Environmental Management Company, Porter Family Trust, Shubert Family Trust, Roberta H. Green, and Willis and Lillie Slaughter.
