NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT FOR ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY COMPLAINT NO. R9-2023-0013

IN THE MATTER OF QUALITY INVESTORS 1 2016 LLC AND DAVID G. EPSTEIN COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board) is considering the adoption of an Administrative Civil Liability Order (ACL Order) against Quality Investors 1 2016 LLC and David G. Epstein (collectively, Respondents) for alleged violations of water quality requirements as set forth in Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) Complaint No. R9-2023-0013.

Based on consideration of the facts stated in ACL Complaint No. R9-2023-0013, the applicable law, and after applying the penalty calculation methodology in section VI of the <u>Enforcement Policy</u>, the Prosecution Team recommended that the San Diego Water Board impose civil liability against the Respondents in the amount of \$411,475 for the violations alleged in the ACL Complaint and set forth in full in Attachment A to Administrative Civil Liability Complaint No. R9-2023-0013: Liability Methodology.

Notice of Opportunity for Public Comment

Pursuant to the Enforcement Policy, a 30-day public comment period shall be posted on the San Diego Water Board's website prior to the imposition of any ACL Order. Interested persons may submit written non-evidentiary policy statements regarding ACL Complaint No. R9-2023-0013, but may not submit evidence (e.g., photographs, eye-witness testimony, and monitoring data). Written non-evidentiary policy statements from interested persons shall be submitted as early as possible, but no later than **5:00 p.m. on December 18, 2022**, to Vincent Vu, Senior Staff Counsel, by email at Vincent.Vu@waterboards.ca.gov, or by mail at the address indicated below. Please indicate in the subject line of all written comments "Comment - ACL Complaint No. R9-2023-0013". The San Diego Water Board may refuse to accept written comments received after the deadline.

The deadline for written comments and policy statements only applies to interested parties. Designated parties, including the Respondents, have separate deadlines for submission of evidence and argument. Designed parties, including the Discharger, should refer to the hearing procedures for additional information about important deadlines.
