The Shipyard Sediment Remediation Project is the dredging of the sediment adjacent to shipyards in San Diego Bay; the dewatering, solidification of the dredged material (onshore or on a barge); the potential treatment of decanted water (anticipated disposal to the sanitary sewer); and the transport of the removed material to an appropriate landfill for disposal. The sediment removal project is located along the eastern shore of San Diego Bay, extending approximately from the Sampson Street Extension on the northwest to Chollas Creek on the southeast, and from the shoreline out the the San Diego Bay shipping channel to the west.


