| DISCUSSION:            | As a result of the San Francisco Superior Court's Writ of Mandate and Statement of<br>Decision issued on November 14, 2003 (see Staff Summary Report, Item No. 8),<br>various administrative approvals to changes to the Stormwater Management Plan<br>since adoption of Order No. 99-058 (a municipal stormwater permit that is described<br>further in the Staff Summary Report in Item No. 8) have in effect been invalidated<br>because they were not subject to the correct notice and comment procedures. This<br>Tentative Order (Appendix A) 99-058 brings those invalidated administrative changes<br>and any pending requests for approvals relating to the Discharger's Stormwater<br>Management Plan to the Regional Board for consideration and adoption under a<br>public process. Adoption of the Tentative Order has the effect of formally approving<br>those efforts that are already being implemented by the Dischargers since they were<br>previously sanctioned by the Board staff. Staff therefore recommends adoption of the<br>Tentative Order.<br>This Tentative Order is distinct from Item No. 8 in that the latter only deals with those<br>amendments to the permit that are necessary to comply with the San Francisco<br>Superior Court's Writ of Mandate and Statement of Decision.<br>The Tentative Order was noticed for public comment in May 2004. The minor and<br>editorial comments received from the Dischargers applied to Item No. 8 only |
|                        | (Appendix C-2 of Item No. 8). A letter in support of this amendment and Item No. 8 was received from the Alameda Countywide Clean Water Program.   |
