SUBJECT: ConocoPhillips San Francisco Refinery, Contra Costa County – Hearing to Consider Mandatory Minimum Penalty for Discharge of Partially Treated Wastewater to Waters of the State

CHRONOLGY: MMP - August 2003.

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DISCUSSION: ConocoPhillips San Francisco Refinery had one serious violation of its NPDES effluent discharge limits during the period between April 1, 2003, and June 30, 2003. This violation is subject to a mandatory minimum penalty (MMP) of \$3,000.

The complaint (Attachment A) imposed an MMP in the total amount of \$3,000. ConocoPhillips San Francisco Refinery has signed a waiver to a Water Board hearing, and intends to undertake a supplemental environmental project (SEP).

The proposed SEP is to add funds to a special project for improving public access to water quality information.
