SUBJECT: **EAST CANYON HOLDINGS, LLC, EAST CANYON LANDFILL, BENICIA, SOLANO COUNTY** - Updated Waste Discharge Requirements and Rescission of Order Nos. 78-003, 78-017, 78-039, 86-096, 95-081, and 95-227

CHRONOLOGY: Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) adopted in 1995.

DISCUSSION: The Tentative Order updates the 1995 WDRs to reflect a recent change in ownership of the landfill and addresses post-closure maintenance and monitoring requirements for the landfill. The Tentative Order also rescinds previous Water Board Orders since those requirements have been adequately addressed and/or consolidated in to the Tentative Order.

The East Canyon Landfill is a 12-acre, closed, unlined landfill located within the Southampton residential community in Benicia. Historically, the landfill was known as the Braito Landfill or Solano County Sanitary Landfill, and was the subject of controversy due to its location within a residential community and questions about the nature of waste disposed there. Those issues have since been addressed and the landfill is currently being used as an open space park under agreement with the City of Benicia and the landfill owner, East Canyon Holdings, LLC.

Staff has incorporated relevant comments submitted by the dischargers. The dischargers have indicated acceptance of the Tentative Order.
