DISCUSSION: Attached are three tables indicating progress made during fiscal year 04-05

toward our UST program goals. We completed 36 case closures, exceeding our goal of 30 by 20%. We met our goal of 500 formal and informal enforcements. We did not meet our goal of 500 (we reviewed 385) monitoring report reviews primarily because we reduced monitoring frequency for some dischargers during the fiscal year. With mature cases quarterly monitoring is not always necessary or cost-effective. With limited resources it is prudent to focus our efforts on case

closures.
