SUBJECT: City of St. Helena, Wastewater Treatment and Reclamation

Plant, Napa County – Reissuance of NPDES Permit

CHRONOLOGY: January 1992 – Permit reissued

DISCUSSION: The City of St. Helena (City) owns and operates a wastewater treatment

and reclamation plant with capacity to treat 0.5 million gallons per day. The plant treats wastewater from residential and commercial sources within the City. In the wet season, effluent is discharged to upper Napa River. In the dry season, effluent is either stored in

ponds or reclaimed for spray irrigation.

We received comments (Appendix B) on the T.O. from the City and have addressed all concerns. The Response to Comments (Appendix C) provides further details on all issues raised and the changes made to the T.O. in response. The attached T.O. reflects

these changes.
