Santa Clara Valley Water District Educational Outreach Program is submitting a proposal for \$6,000. We are excited about the potential for the expansion of our water education outreach program. If approved, we will use the funds for our Coyote Creek Outdoor Classroom. The Santa Clara Valley Water District solely funds the current program at Coyote Creek.

The additional funding will allow us to reach an additional 300 students. It will purchase the necessary equipment and provide additional staffing for presentations to students for the 2003-2004 school year.

The equipment we would like to purchase includes:


- An enviroscape to teach about urban runoff \$904.00
- 10 Binoculars @ \$50.00 for wildlife viewing 500.00
- Weather station & teaching materials 650.00
- Water quality testing kits & teaching materials 196.00

Staffing would include five teachers @ \$25/hour each, for 3 hours per session times 10 sessions. Total costs for staffing would be \$3,750.00. **The materials and staffing totals equal \$6,000.00.**

The additional classes will be held on Mondays and Fridays, September through November and March through May. We will be working with students in the middle grades. All materials will be consistent with state standards.

A summary report on this project will be submitted to you by June 30, 2004.
