Dear Mr. Porter:

The Regional Water Board intends to consider (1) Complaint No. R2-2008-0065 for an administrative civil liability in the amount of \$23,375 and (2) a tentative cease and desist order for the Crystal Springs County Sanitation District (District) during a meeting that will commence at the time and place indicated below:

The Complaint alleges that the District violated the following requirements:

State Water Resources Control Board Order No. 2006-0003 DWQ

Prohibitions C.1 and C.2

Water Quality Control Plan for the San Francisco Bay Basin (Basin Plan):

Discharge Prohibition 15

The violations consist of 22 unauthorized discharges totaling 19,000 gallons of raw sewage to waters of the State during the period December 1, 2004, though May 31, 2008. The Complaint describes the alleged violations in detail.

The District has the following options:

- 1. The District can appear before the Regional Water Board at the meeting to contest the matter. Written comments and evidence shall be submitted by the deadline indicated below and in accordance with the process set forth in the attached Public Notice. At the meeting, the Regional Water Board may impose an administrative civil liability in the amount proposed or for a different amount, decline to seek civil liability, or refer the case to the Attorney General for judicial enforcement.
- 2. The District can waive the right to a hearing to contest the allegations contained in the Complaint by paying the civil liability in full.

If the District waives its right to a hearing, the District must mail and fax a copy of the signed waiver by the time and date specified below to the attention of Michael Chee of my staff at (510) 622-2460.

Tentative Cease and Desist Order

The tentative cease and desist order for the District requires actions to reduce and eliminate sanitary sewer overflows (SSOs) from its sanitary sewer collection system (collection system). In doing so, the tentative cease and desist order requires that the City not cause or contribute to SSOs by other associated collection systems.

Deadline for Comments

The deadline for submittal of written comments and evidence to the Complaint and tentative cease and desist order, and waiver is **October 16, 2008, at 5 p.m.**

Draft Notice of Public Hearing

Enclosed you will find a draft notice that sets forth the procedures I am recommending that the Regional Water Board follow in conducting the public hearing. Please note that comments on the draft notice including these proposed procedures are due on **September 23, 2008**, to Bruce Wolfe, the Regional Water Board's technical advisor (mailing address shown in draft notice).
